Poker hand V43542\_en

Write a **function** that given 3 Poker cards returns a description (a string) of the hand they represent. The description must be one of the following four possibilities: "Trio of Aces!", "Trio", "Pair", or "All cards different".

The cards are one of the following 13 characters: A, 2, 3, ..., 9, 0, J, Q, K. There are two characters worth explaining: the card A is the Ace and represents 1, as in normal decks, and the digit 0 represents 10, to simplify reading.

The function header is, exactly:

```
/**
* @pre c1, c2, c3 in {A, 2, 3, ..., 8, 9, 0, J, Q, K}
* @post Returns "Trio of Aces!", "Trio", "Pair", or
* "All cards different" according to c1, c2, and c3.
*/
string poker_hand(char c1, char c2, char c3);
```
