## Capital letter counter

Write a function `cap_let_counter(s)` that returns the number of capital letters in string `s`. You can use the string method `isupper()` to check whether given a string it has at least one letter and all its letters are capital letters. For instance, `my_string.isupper()` is `True` when `my_string` is `'HELLO'` or `'1X2'` or `'G'` and is `False` when `my_string` is `'He7TO'` or `'x'` or `'123456'`.

### Sample session

```
>>> cap_let_counter('Game Over')
2
>>> cap_let_counter('Add: 3 + 5')
1
>>> cap_let_counter('000MONTsERRAT000')
9
```
